- Develop an understanding of current trends and development in orienteering coaching throughout the world and assist, through the OA Manager Coaching & Officiating Development, in promulgating this information to the individual coaches of squad/team members.
- Be an ex officio member of the OA Coaching Committee.
- Represent OA at national and international coaching meetings, workshops etc. as determined by mutual agreement with the Board.
